New Manor Road Quarter

This project will offer a mix of residential and commercial space, and a high-quality public realm including a new 1 hectare linear park adjacent to the DLR.

What works we have done so far?

Block A - 32 Stories

- The concrete frame is currently at level 22, with 10 floors left to go
- Internal fit out works have commenced with Mechanical and electrical and drylining works.

Blocks B & C – 9 and 12 stories

- Concrete frame is finished, roofing has commenced
- The Apartment fit out is well underway with the first apartments nearly ready for decoration.

What's coming up Next Month?

- We will shortly be raising our tower crane up by another 30m to complete the top section of the concrete frame to block A
- Internal fit out trades will continue in all blocks with drylining, Mechanical & Electrical, Carpentry, tiling and decoration works.

Since the project commenced, we have created the following opportunities:

- 205 new vacancies for people who were previously unemployed
- 31 apprentices
- 19 students provided with work experience
- 5 undergraduates/graduates working full time on the project
- 2 T-Level students on 45-day industrial placement
- 14 operatives achieved an NVQ recently
- Supported 22 school/college events
- Engaged with 1568 students
